Ask for Feedback


Let students choose their learning way

You can ignite feedback from your students by imposing relevant questions requiring irrefutable answers.

Selecting topics and units and then picking what's relevant to all. This idea will make everyone engaged in what they need to learn. Ensure it's within their scope.

You can put some social touches to your teaching by asking and responding on topics discussed, making everyone interactive.

Do not be the only one to talk during the whole online lesson. Let the students contribute.
